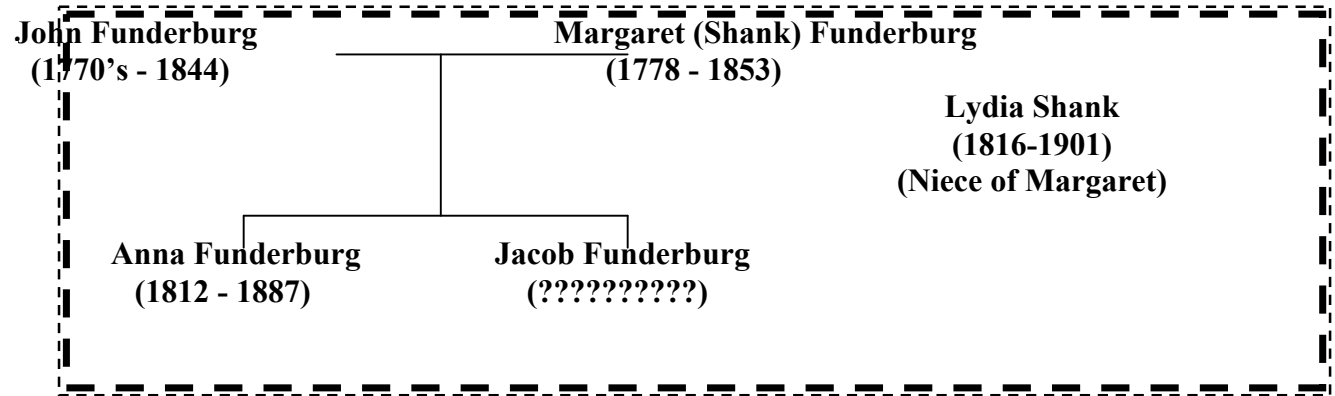


CENTURY HOUSE FAMILY TREE
